The North Texas Re-Entry Coalition (North TREC) is comprised of local non-profit agencies, housing providers, municipalities, churches, government agencies, and county residents who are interested in assisting persons who are homeless and potentially homeless to achieve self-sufficiency and gain affordable housing. North TREC full committee meetings are usually held quarterly but may be held as often as monthly. The North TREC Steering Committee may organize subcommittees to work on specific goals and projects. Membership information will be updated on an annual basis. North TREC members are expected to attend full committee meetings. Meeting attendance is documented for community and county collaborative grant efforts. Failure to attend meetings has an adverse financial effect on the entire coalition. Members will be dropped from the membership roster after missing three consecutive meetings.
